### Learning objectives

- Gain an appreciation that the world has many places which are different to where we live
- Understand that maps give us information about our world
- Understand that the Earth is spherical in shape
- Appreciate the world is diverse with varied landscapes and climates
- Gain an awareness that visiting new places can be exciting
