

Jungle senses

Learning objectives

- Recognise that the jungle is also called the rainforest
- Understand that the rainforest is hot and wet
- Gain an appreciation that many types of plants and animals live in the rainforest
- Understand that different plants and animals live in different layers of the rainforest
- Understand that humans live in the rainforest
- Understand that some everyday foods come from the rainforest

Workshop content - students will:

- Think about what it would be like to be in a rainforest
- Colour in a rainforest animal and learn what layer it lives in
- Investigate rainforest artefacts using their sense of touch and smell
- Listen to the sounds of different rainforest animals
- Make a rainforest animal to take home
